Also note **most of these sites are free** to use.

#1, vWorker.com



Like to earn a part time/fulltime income as a freelancer? Then, this site facilitates you to do this, with the **freedom to decide** how much, when, how often and where in the globe you desire to work. You need **three things** to get started. A marketable skill, the power to communicate well and computer with a net connection. That's it.

Your payment is guaranteed! Conventional freelance workers waste much of their clock time on non-productively tasks such as payment collection and fussing over clients that won't pay. #2, ScriptLance.com



ScriptLance is a freelance marketplace that helps buyers find programmers and designers to outsource their projects. Freelancers place bids on projects posted by buyers, who then work with the chosen winner to complete their programming work.

#3) ODesk.com



Odesk is a great site to find work on **multiple areas** like web designing programming, freelance writing, and remote jobs.

For e.g. telephone operators, back end office work and more of such

freelance jobs.

You can start with the basics oDesk: First, post a well prepared profile and fill in your past work history and skills.

Take a few online skill tests to verify your skills. Upload examples of your past work to your portfolio. Do your best to make sure that when an employer verifies your application, he will be impressed.

Then **start applying for jobs** with the registered employers!

Try out small jobs first. Do a good job of them. Build positive feedbacks on the work done by you and then go after the bigger fish. oDesk's forum, blog and newsletters often have more tips for landing your first jobs.

Freelancer.com is a website that provides an online job marketplace for **freelance workers** from around the world.

Buyers (individuals or companies) outsource their work to freelancers. Freelancers may be **full or part time** self-employed persons. Or can be those who wish to make some extra money on an ad hoc basis.

Once a buyer has selected a provider, *they are each provided with the other's contact details.*

It is up to the buyer and freelancer to mutually agree a timeframe for project completion and payment schedule. [Free Registration.](#)

#5, Greatlance.com



Greatlance is free to join for both Buyers and Providers except, that the provider will be charged 10% of the project Fee.

As a freelancer you can **set a profile** showcasing your experience, vision, and talent visible to buyers immediately after posting it. You can also **view and bid for project** based on your specialization.

Greatlance provides two types of Freelance Providers Membership. Normal and Premium.

Normal members pay the 10% of their Project fee on Greatlance. Premium members only pay 10\$ one time flat fee for a life time. [Free Registration](#).

#6, Getacoder.com



GetACoder is a business outsourcing site that brings together internet freelancers and the buyers who want their services.

The platform works with freelancers who provide such services as website content and articles, website development and design, and script and software programming. Buyers post their projects and **freelancers bid on them** to get the job.

Buyers and freelancers can [sign on with GetACoder for free](#).

Buyers only need to **pay the actual fee** what freelancers charge and no more. While freelancers pay up a commission to the company for the jobs they finish.

#7, Project4hire.com



Project 4 Hire is a freelance job site where you post projects and get jobs done at competitive prices.

As a freelancer, **you will have access** to a wide range of jobs that suits your skills. Open to all freelancers from all over the world.

The freelance jobs can be in areas like website development and promotion, software and programming, writing, graphic design, business cards, ebook writing, database design, marketing, hardware support, sales, seo and so on. [Free Registration](#).

LegitimateOnlineJobs.com is a paid membership site that provides each of its members with **full access** to the best, professionally reviewed, and totally verified online jobs. *Both full time and part time jobs as well as contractual jobs are available.*

This is a paid membership site of about \$49/year and not free.

#9) [MechanicalTurk.com](https://www.mechanicalturk.com)



Run by [Amazon.com](https://www.amazon.com) but the basic idea is that of Microworkers. You do errands that do not need much of time investment but earn from 1 cent to \$10 for each task completed. They call these task as *Human Intelligent tasks* (HIT).

You don't make a lot of money here but if you require \$50 to buy a book from Amazon, a few nights at mechanical turk will get you enough cash to pick it up.

It's also a great place if you are a website owner.

Simply outsource annoying errands like bookmarking pages on your site, getting 'likes' on Facebook, or getting people to comment on your blog for SEO by actual humans.

#10) [MicroWorkers.com](https://www.microworkers.com)



MicroWorkers constitutes a web site where you'll be able to **do elementary odd jobs** like posting links on blogs, facebook liking and uploading pictures and so forth. For each job you finish, you can earn from a cent to a dollar or more.

Certainly, you won't become a millionaire by doing errands for others on Microworkers, but if you love of surfing the internet, then this site can **earn you** some extra dollars.

Spending a few evenings on this site can fetch you enough to buy a gift for your loved ones.

#11) VIPdesk.com



VIP Desk is a site where **they continually recruit and cultivate** highly capable professionals from a wide variety of backgrounds to join their work-at-home virtual team.

They provide Virtual Contact Center, Concierge Services, and Loyalty Programs. You can get jobs like phone operator, customer service representative, virtual receptionist and so forth.

(**Note:** You have to be a US citizen and Canada to some extent).

#12) Suite101.com



Want to bring **the hidden writer in you** and earn an income?

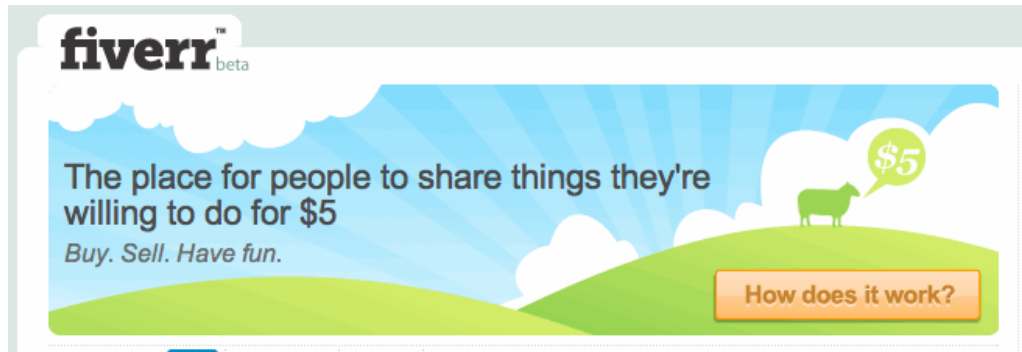
Suite101's writing community offers writers from around the world the opportunity to publish compelling, non fiction articles and *earn residual income*.

#13) Fiverr.com



The concept behind Fiverr is simple- “What can you do for \$5 that adds value to others”? *Whatever it may be?*

You can post what tasks you are willing to do for other people and **buyers will pay you \$5** to do that task. Some examples of gigs on fiverr (as the posts are called by them).

- I will draw anything for \$5
- I will edit and proofread audio transcripts
- I will write a short rap for you on whatever subject you would like for \$5

Got the idea how Fiverr.com works! Ideally, you should be offering something creative that you can finish in 5 minutes and get paid \$5 for the task.

#14) Onlineverdict.com



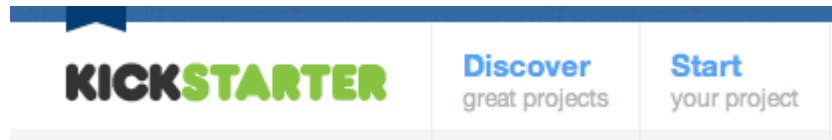
Lawyers or legal professionals will post a case summary and verdict questions for participants to answer. The participants *who are jury eligible and match the demographics* of the selected venue will then be emailed an invitation to review the case.

You need to **answer them** as a participant and get paid for it. If the participant chooses to review the case summary and completes the case questions, they will receive a check in the mail within one month of participation. It is that simple.

Each case review may take anywhere from 20-60 minutes to complete depending on the length of the case summary and the number of attorney-provided questions. Juror payment amounts (\$20-\$60) reflect the amount of time it takes to review a case.

(**Note:** You need to be a US citizen over 18 years old to participate).

#15) Kickstarter.com



Do you have a great project in your mind that needs funding? Try here! Kickstarter is a new way to fund creative projects.

If you have a good idea that is communicated across well that can spread fast and wide, then **you have access** to a large group of people who can fund the project and who can provide the necessary encouragement.

It goes like this. You set a monetary goal with a dead line of 60-90 days for raising the money. You need to invest \$50 for this.

Next, you promote it to your friends, family, colleagues and the kickstarter community.

If people falls in love with your idea and want to see it realized, then you hit your financial goal for the project. *You will get all the money you set in your monetary goal* to accomplish the project. May be even more. And they take 5% of the collected amount.

Now, If you don't, you loose out on the initial \$50 you paid and the donations promised to you will not be charged to the people who committed them.

Now the real benefit here is you can **get a market feedback** on your project – whether it is a financially viable or not! That means, you get a sort of valuable market research done for just \$50!

And if it works, you get funded for the whole project.

Got the idea! A cool, cool one.

#16) Indiegogo.com -



Have any idea that you are passionate about?

You can **create a funding campaign** to raise money quickly and securely by tapping into your network of supporters and beyond. This trusted platform has helped to raise millions of dollars for over 25,000 campaigns, across 183 countries.

The beauty with Indiegogo is that, *it doesn't cost a dime to kick start your project.*

You need to part with 4% of the money you collect but you still get to keep the money you generated even *if you don't make it to your financial goal.* And your project can run for 120 days.

#17) Freelancezone.com.sg



This is freelance website based in Singapore. Basically meant for freelancers and companies in the South East Asia.

Many types of jobs are available. For e.g. IT, media, consultation

services, accounting, finance, engineering, medical, photography, writers, sales and marketing and more. [Free Registration](#).

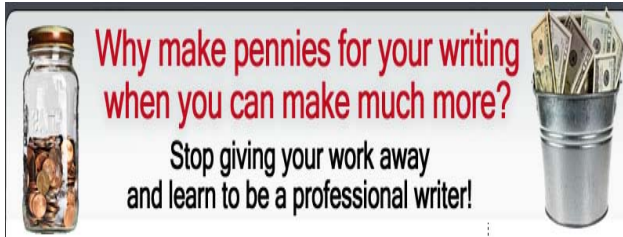
